Course Description and Objective: This course will focus mainly on improving your communicative skills in Korean. Authentic and meaningful language will be introduced and practiced to help you perform various tasks in different situations, especially when you are visiting Korea. Cultural aspects will also be addressed using various visual aids and hands-on activities.

Student Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the semester, students will be able to:

- handle various activities, such as greeting, ordering, and getting information on food items at a restaurant
- ask for help to use public transportation and ask and give directions
- ask for help and ask and negotiate price at department stores and open markets

Textbook: There is no required textbook for this course. All materials will be provided by the instructor throughout the semester.

General Requirements:

- Absences: Students are expected to attend all classes. If there is an absence to be expected, please notify the instructor beforehand so that the instructor can prepare for the lesson accordingly. If the absence was an emergency so that you could not notify the instructor beforehand, let the instructor still know about it so that the instructor can provide you materials that you missed.
